2. The official Start Date is Thursday, 5 October. If the entry in either the Men's or the Women's event is more than 16 teams, some teams will have to play on the evening of Wednesday, 4 October 2006, in which case the Start Date will be brought forward to 4 October and all teams will be advised as soon as possible.
3. The Championship Director will be Michael Bische
4. The ESF Technical Director will be Martin Wren.
5. The Championship Referee will be David McAlpine
6. The Championships Adjudicating Panel (CAP) will be the ESF Technical Director, the Championships Director and the Championships Referee. (If a member of the CAP is from an MNA that is involved in or associated with an appeal, the ESF Technical Director shall co-opt a neutral person for that appeal).
7. The Championships will be run in accordance with the latest version of the Rules Governing the European Club Championships which are available on the ESF website www.europeansquash.com



SCHEDULE

1. Matches will start early on **Thursday morning 5 October** and finish on **Saturday, 7 October** at the end of the afternoon. If the entry in either the Men's or the Women's event is more than 16 teams, some teams will have to play on the evening of Wednesday, 4 October 2006, in which case the Start Date will be brought forward to 4 October and all teams will be advised as soon as possible.
2. The official opening ceremony will take place on Wednesday 4 October at 20.00 hrs (8pm).
3. The prize-giving ceremony will take place on the Saturday after the Finals.
4. The format of the Championships will be determined by the number of entries received. Teams should expect to play up to six matches to determine a full final order.
5. The Finals Party will be held on Saturday night 7 October.

ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT

1. The tournament hotel rooms have double or twin beds, bath/shower, toilet.
2. Transport to and from the Squash Club will be scheduled.
3. Teams will be met at the Malmö South Railway Station, Svågertorp (max. 10 min by train from Copenhagen Airport – train runs every 20 min) or at Malmö Sturup Airport (max. 25 min drive).
4. **Package**
Each team will be required to pay an amount of **€340 per person** (player, manager, official, supporter) which will cover four nights' hotel accommodation (Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday), all meals from evening on Wednesday until lunch on Saturday plus transportation and social activities (including the finals party). For single rooms, there will be an extra charge of **€31 per night**.
5. Teams which do not want to take this package have to pay an **Entry Fee of €18 per person** per day, which covers the organizational costs, but does not include transportation, food, hotel and the players party. **The Finals Party costs €31 per person**.
6. The total amount must be paid in Euros to the Malmö Squash Rackets Club account shown in the section "**Payment**" by Monday, 7 August 2006.

LATE ENTRIES AND WITHDRAWALS

Late entries may be accepted for the following period with the approval of the ESF Technical Director:

8 July – 7 August	The Entry Fee is doubled per team
8 August – 5 September	The Entry Fee is trebled per team

NOTIFICATION OF DRAW AND MATCH SCHEDULES

The Seedings and Draws will be issued in accordance with Rule L8. The summary timetable is reproduced below. **Please note that the Seedings and Draws will be published by 18.00 hrs on the day before the Start Date and this information will not be available before that time.**

By noon 2 days before the Start Date	Squad orders must be lodged with the Championships Director with player "bands". Failure to do this will incur a fine of €40 for every hour that the team order is late.
2 hours before the Managers Meeting	Championships Director will publish all squad orders and daily playing orders for both Men's and Women's event (see M1).
1 hour before the Managers Meeting	Objections to squad orders and player eligibility must be lodged with the Championships Director.
At the Managers Meeting	The Championships Director will announce the final decision of the CAP. There is no right of appeal.

The format and planned playing times, including the need for play on the Wednesday evening, will be advised as soon as possible. Teams will be seeded in accordance with Rule G.

ELIGIBILITY

C2

Any team reporting to the Championships with less than four eligible men or three eligible women will not be allowed to take part in the Championships.

The composition of all squads entering the Championships shall comply with the conditions stated in the tables below. The Entry/Team Order Form shall list all players in a squad showing PSA/WISPA/National rankings where available as at the Closing Date for entries. Players who are not members of PSA/WISPA but have held a PSA/WISPA ranking in the preceding 12 months prior to the Closing Date shall be banded as shown, except that if any player is nominated in a squad and correctly ranked on current form at the Closing Date above any PSA/WISPA member, then he/she will be given the same notional Band and Points as the player nominated immediately below him/her.

- C3** A player shall be eligible to represent a Club in the Championships only:
- a if he is eligible to represent a Country in the European Team Championships **and**
 - b if he has played for the Club in the qualifying competition on **two** or more occasions.
 - c Rule 3a may be waived for **one** player in the team; and Rule 3b maybe waived for one player in the squad, provided that the player is of lower strength than all other members of the squad and provided that the player has represented the Club in inter-Club competition on at least **two** occasions in the past 12 months
 - d A player is eligible to play for only one club in the Championships (excluding the qualifying competitions).
- C4** In all cases where a player's eligibility is in doubt, it is obligatory upon the MNA for which the player wishes to play, to prove eligibility to the satisfaction of the ESF Officers before the Start Date.
